Volunteer Physician Specialists donated over *\$9 Million in specialty care, surgeries and services this year alone, to low income, at risk, uninsured and underinsured Iowans 200% below FEDERAL POVERTY LEVELS and who do not qualify for any other assistance!*

Providers

Over 484

12 new providers were recruited in 1-3 qtrs. to serve our patients.

These providers represent **more than 60** specialty and subspecialty health care services.

During these quarters the VPN **recruited** new **Gastroenterology, Plastic Surgery, Urology Podiatry & Vascular Surgery Specialists** to participate in the VPN program.



Partnerships

We have partnerships with All **Des Moines Hospitals & Surgery Centers**

In our service area Together, we have developed innovative programs to fill the gaps in a changing health care system.



We remain committed to providing free access to specialty care for uninsured Iowans through our network of volunteer physicians and partners at Des Moines hospitals and surgery centers.



Patient Service and Impact Snapshots:

CASE #1: VPN received a Nephrology referral for a 46 year old female patient diagnosed with renal failure. The patient has been treated multiple times in the specialist's office and was hospitalized for 15 day period, and required a renal biopsy, testing and several infusions. The specialist will continue ongoing treatment which includes extensive follow up care, additional testing, and referrals to additional specialists. **The donated cost of care to date is well over \$270,000 and is still incurring with additional services and specialty visits as warranted.**

CASE #2: The VPN received a General Surgery referral for a 38 year old male patient diagnosed with a significant left inguinal hernia. The patient had previously been referred to VPN for an ultrasound that was completed to confirm the hernia. He had been in pain for several months, and his hernia was getting larger, he was missing work due to the pain and was concerned he would lose his job. This patient was referred to a VPN General Surgery specialist. After a consultation and examination; the specialist proceeded to repair the inguinal hernia with mesh. This was a successful outcome for the patient who then returned to work. The cost and care involved for the surgery includes Radiology services, surgical cost of the facility, physician, anesthesiologist, pathology, as well as the ongoing post-operative follow up with the surgeon.

The donated cost of care for this patient to date is well over \$47,000.00.
